About 500 years ago, China's Wushu began to be passed on to the people of the Ryukyu, where it was integrated with the local Wushu and called 'Tang-Te' (in Japanese 'To-De'). Tang-te consists of three main styles: Shuri-Te, Naha-Te, and Tomari-Te. Naha-Te originated from Nanquan in Fuzhou, China.

To celebrate Okinawan traditional Karate and the second anniversary of the founding of China Fuzhou Karatedo Association, it was decided to host the 2011 Fuzhou International Karate-Wushu Spectacular and Exchange Convention in Nov.4-8.

- bring various schools of Karate from different countries of the world together;

- improve the health of mankind both mentally and physically;
- raise the skill of Karate and Wushu;
- promote friendship and mutual understandings;
- raise the awareness of Fuzhou.

## Rules

2011 China Fuzhou International Karate-Wushu Spectacular and Exchange Convention.

- 1、Sponsored by: China Fuzhou Sports Federation.
- 2、Hosted by: China Fuzhou Karatedo Association.
- 3、Dates: November 4-8, 2011.
- 4、Location: Fuzhou Gymnasium.
- 5、Competition Events:
  - 1) Karate: Individual kata, team kata (teams of three)
  - 2) Wushu: Participants are restricted to a maximum of 2 events from any category
    - (a) Traditional quan (all styles) –boxing, weapon, dual practice
    - (b) Taiji quan: boxing, weapon, dual practice
    - (c) Taekwondo: individual or group (6-8 persons).

3) Organized in groups:

Groups	Group A	Group B	Group C	Group D
Female & Male (group)	under 16 years old	17-32 years old	33-54 years old	55 years and over

- 6、Ways for participation:
  - 1) All practitioners of Karate or Wushu are eligible to participate.
  - 2) A team/delegation consists of three or more persons.
  - 3) A delegation may have one group chief and one instructor. There is no restriction on the number for participants.
  - 4) Each participant may only enter two events from any category in the events listed in part 5 above.
  - 5) The organization is not responsible or liable for any injuries.
- 7、Competition and exchange rules:
  - 1) Judging will be based on the “[Matching Means for Traditional Wushu Skills & Tricks,](#)” which has been approved in 2006 by the China Wushu Association, and other rules concerned as well.
  - 2) The same kinds of Wushu and Weapons are centralized to make in groups. It is

centralized to be organized in “other group” for the participants of less than 3 persons.

3) Spectacular time for the events of Wushu:

- (1) Not over 20 minutes for traditional boxing & weapons;
- (2) Not less than 40 minutes for dual practice;
- (3) 4-6 minutes for Taiji quan, When reaching the 5<sup>th</sup> minute, judge’s whistle is for reminding.
- (4) 3-4 minutes for Taiji weapon; when reaching the 3<sup>rd</sup> minute, the judge’s whistle is for reminding.

8、 Karate and Fuzhou Traditional Nanquan seminar (Fuzhou Traditional Southern Style)

- 1) Seminar: Goju-Ryu, Crane style, Lion style, Tiger style, Ground style, Arhat style, Bird-style.

9、 Registration and fees:

- 1) Preliminary registration: Before **June 30**, 2011 the titles of the groups and the number of participants is required.
- 2) Final registration: Before **September 30**, 2011, the registration forms must be completed (in duplicate). Please include detailed names and the events for each participant. At this time the registration fees will also be required.  
No changes will be allowed.
- 3) The date and location for check-in: Check-in will be on November 4, 2011, in the lobby of the Apollo Great Hotel (Wu Yi Road, Fuzhou, China).
- 4) Registration fee: The registration fee for each participant is \$450 USD (This includes accommodation, traffic, and sightseeing). Each event of seminar is USD\$20.
